PSI's MISSION

PSI's PRODUCTS

PSI currently has three products. Origen and DS Standard provide solutions for change management in NetWare bindery and NetWare Directory Services (NDS)-based environments, respectively. AuditWare for NetWare Binderies provides security auditing for NetWare 2, NetWare 3, and NetWare 4 bindery-based environments. AuditWare for NDS will ship in the first half of 1996.

PSI's OFF-LINE PHILOSOPHY

The key to PSI's advanced product architecture is its off-line database. It is this database that provides network managers with the ability to make changes without affecting users, while at the same time providing a built-in "*safety net*". Network managers can now apply time-tested MIS practices when managing NetWare, such as staging changes, prototyping or design modeling, and recovery planning.
